

General Authorisation No. 6 (outdoor leisure facilities) - Coronavirus

Authorisation to enter outdoor leisure facilities

Further to its powers under paragraph 1(2)(d) of Direction No. 5 of the Committee *for* Health & Social Care made on 24th April, 2020 ("the Direction"), the Committee hereby disapplies the prohibition on entering and remaining on premises under the Direction, in relation to any person who meets with one other person on relevant premises for the purpose of playing or engaging in sporting or recreational activities.

"relevant premises" means any outdoor leisure facility, the owner, occupier or operator of which has notified the Director of Environmental Health and Pollution Regulation and the Medical Officer of Health by completion and electronic submission of the relevant form accessible via the States of Guernsey GOV.GG website and notified those office holders of any change in the details submitted in the Notification Form.

When exercising rights under this Authorisation, persons must adopt practices designed to minimise wherever possible and practical risks to health, including maintenance of social distancing of at least 2 metres and such guidance, advice or other measures as the Committee or Medical Officer of Health may from time to time publish in relation to playing or engaging in sporting or recreational activities.

Unless revoked or varied, this Authorisation has effect from Saturday 2nd May, 2020 until 2359 hours on Friday 8th May, 2020.
