

Variation No. 1 of the Civil Contingencies Authority made under the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 10) Regulations, 2021

Introduction

This document is made by the Civil Contingencies Authority under regulation 8(4) of the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 10) Regulations, 2021 ("**the Regulations**"). It is a variation of the requirement to self-isolate under regulation 5(1) or 6(2) in respect of a specified category of persons. References in this variation to a regulation are references to that provision of the Regulations.

Terms used in this variation (for example, "appointed officer") have the meaning given in the Regulations.

Who does this variation apply to?

This variation applies only in relation to persons arriving in the Bailiwick from outside, who–

- a) are 16 or 17 years old on the date of their arrival in the Bailiwick, and
- b) have received one dose of a vaccine against coronavirus, the use of which is authorised by the European Medicines Agency or the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency of the United Kingdom, administered at least 14 days before the date of their arrival in the Bailiwick.

A person to whom this variation would otherwise apply may elect for it not to apply to him or her. Any person who makes such an election will have to self-isolate in accordance with the Regulations, and comply with any other applicable restrictions and requirements.

What is the effect of this variation?

A person to whom this variation applies shall be deemed to be a Blue Arrival for the purposes of the Regulations (and consequently will be required to comply with the post-arrival testing requirements set out in regulation 20).

False information

If a person makes a statement or provides evidence to a relevant officer or an appointed officer which is subsequently found to be false, this variation shall lapse as it applies to that person, and he or she may be liable to prosecution under the Regulations.
