THE ROYAL COURT (DAYS OF SITTING) ORDER, 1960.

THE ROYAL COURT, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and by section twelve of the Royal Court (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950, hereby order:—

1. The first sentence in paragraph 5 of the Saisie Procedure (Simplification) (Bailiwick) Order, 1952, is hereby deleted and the following sentence is hereby substituted therefor—

“In Guernsey, sittings of the Court “en Plaids d’Héritage” shall be held on the first Tuesday of each Court Term and on alternate Tuesdays thereafter in each such Term.”.

2. The Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative à la Cour des Plaids d’Heritage”, made permanent on the eighteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, is hereby repealed.

3. This Order shall come into force on the twentieth day of August, nineteen hundred and sixty.
