

### **THE ADOPTION (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1963.**

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section ten of the Adoption (Guernsey) Law, 1960, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. Rule 2 of the Adoption Rules, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") is hereby Amendment of rule 2.

amended by adding immediately after the word “thereto” appearing at the end thereof, the following—

“and, if the applicant so wishes, in the case of an application to which section 41 of the Law relates and made before the fifteenth day of March, 1966, Form 1A”.

Amendment  
of rule 10.

2. Rule 10 of the principal Rules is hereby amended—

(a) by adding immediately after the word “application” appearing at the end thereof, the following—

“and in the case of an application to which section 41 of the Law relates consider any request made on Form 1A”;

(b) by re-numbering the existing rule 10, as amended, as rule 10 (1); and

(c) by adding thereto a new rule 10 (2) as follows:—

“(2) Where in pursuance of rule 2 of these Rules a request has been made in Form 1A for service of notice of the application on a parent or guardian to be dispensed with the Court, if satisfied that in all the circumstances of the case it is right so to do, may grant the request and direct Her Majesty’s Greffier accordingly.”.

Amendment  
of rule 12.

3. Rule 12 (1) of the principal Rules is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word “shall” in line 3 thereof the following—

“subject to any direction given under rule 10 (2)”.

Amendment  
of First  
Schedule.

4. The First Schedule to the principal Rules is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the Form 1 appearing therein a new Form 1A as follows—

IN THE MATTER OF the Adoption (Guernsey) Law, 1960

5. (1) These Rules may be cited as the Adoption (Amendment) Rules, 1963 and these Rules and the principal Rules may be cited together as the Adoption Rules, 1961 and 1963.
