THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section six of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. The provisions of paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section six of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950, shall come into operation on the fourth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, as regards criminal causes and matters and civil causes and matters.
