### **The Shorthand Notes and Transcripts (Criminal Cases) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Rules, 1985**

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 41(2) of the Court of Appeal (Guernsey) Law, 1961(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. The Shorthand Notes and Transcripts (Criminal Cases) (Guernsey) Rules, 1964(b) (hereinafter called "the principal Rules") are amended as follows:—

- (a) in Rule 5(1)(a) thereof the words “in respect of each folio or part of a folio thereof, the sum of two shillings” are repealed and the words “in respect of each foolscap page or part of a foolscap page thereof, the sum of three pounds” are substituted therefor;
- (b) in Rule 5(1)(b) thereof the words “in respect of each folio or part of a folio of each additional copy, the sum of two pence” are repealed and the words “in respect of each foolscap page or part of a foolscap page of each additional copy, the sum of fifty pence” are substituted therefor;
- (c) in Rule 5(2)(b) the words “Her Majesty’s Attorney General” are repealed and the words “the President of the Court of Appeal” are substituted therefor.

(3) The Rules shall come into force on the 19th day of February, 1985.
