The Magistrate's Court Fees (Amendment) Rules, 1987

THE ROYAL COURT in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 25 of the Magistrate's Court (Guernsey) Law, 1954, as amended^(a), and of all other powers thereto enabling it hereby orders:—

Amendment
to the Rules
of 1981.

1. The Magistrate's Court (Fees) Rules, 1981 as amended^(b) are further amended as follows:—

(a) In Rule 2(1) the words "ten pounds" are repealed and the words "twenty pounds" are substituted therefor;

(b) At the end of Rule 2 there is added a further paragraph to be numbered "(3)" as follows:—

(3) "Unless otherwise ordered by the Magistrate's Court any amount or allowance ordered to be paid to a witness in accordance with the provisions of this Rule shall be recoverable by that witness as a civil debt and for the purposes of execution the order of the Magistrate's Court ordering the payment of the allowance to the witness shall have the effect of a judgment of a Civil Court for the like amount in favour of that witness".

Current proceedings.

2. These Rules shall not have effect in relation to any proceeding or matter in the Court commenced before the coming into force of these Rules.

Citation.

3. These Rules may be cited as the Magistrate's Court (Fees) (Amendment) Rules, 1987.

Collective Title.

4. These Rules and the Magistrate's Court (Fees) Rules, 1981 and 1984 may be cited together as the Magistrate's Court (Fees) Rules, 1981 to 1987.

5. These Rules shall come into force on the third day of November, 1987. Commence
