The Financial Services Commission (Form of Oath) Order, 1988

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 1 to the Financial Services Commission (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1987, hereby orders:—

1. The oath required to be taken under paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 1 to the Financial Services Commission (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1987(a) is Form of oath.

(a) Order in Council No. XIX of 1987.

“ You swear and promise upon the faith and truth that you owe to God that you will well and faithfully perform the functions of a member of the Guernsey Financial Services Commission in accordance with the law for the time being in force and without favour or partiality.”
