### The Royal Court (Plaids d’Héritage) Order, 1995

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a) and section 12 of the Royal Court (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

#### Amendment of 1952 Order.

1. For the first sentence of paragraph 5 of the Saisie Procedure (Simplification) (Bailiwick) Order, 1952, as amended(c), substitute the following-

“5. In Guernsey, sittings of the Court “en Plaids d’Héritage” shall be held at least once in each calendar month both in and out of term on such dates as shall from time to time be appointed by the Bailiff.”

#### Citation.

2. This Order may be cited as the Royal Court (Plaids d’Héritage) Order, 1995.

#### Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 12th December, 1995.
