The Judgments (Interest) Rules, 1996

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 2 of the Judgments (Interest) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1985(a), hereby orders:-

Reduction of rate of interest on judgment debts.

1. In section 2 of the Judgments (Interest) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1985 for the words “ten per centum” substitute “8%”.

2. These Rules may be cited as the Judgments (Interest) Rules, 1996.

Commencement.

3. These Rules shall come into force on the 1st October, 1996.
