

The Royal Court (Publication of Notices, etc) Order, 2006

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948^a and section 12 of the Royal Court (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950^b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Notices to be displayed in vestibule of new Royal Court extension.

1. Any duty or authorisation, however expressed, to publish or display any notice or other document within, or to affix any notice or other document to any notice board inside, the vestibule of the Royal Court or Royal Court House, and any practice pursuant to which any notice or other document is so published, displayed or affixed, shall have effect after the date of commencement of this Order-

- (a) as a duty or authorisation to publish or display the notice or other document within, or to affix the notice or other document to any notice board inside, the vestibule (presently known as the Grand Hall) of the extension to the Royal Court building in St James Street, or, as the case may be,
- (b) as a practice pursuant to which the notice or other document is so published, displayed or affixed

2. This Order may be cited as the Royal Court (Publication of Notices, etc) Order, 2006.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 16th January, 2006.
