THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) (GUERNSEY) REGULATIONS, 1945, AMENDMENT (NO. 2) ORDER, 1950.

The Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1948, and of the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1947, and of Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. Regulation 43A of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, is hereby revoked.

2. The Ordinance directing that certain Defence Regulations shall have effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey, of the 16th day of February, 1946 is hereby amended by deleting, in the First Schedule thereto, in the first column of that Schedule, the figures and letter "43A", and in the second column thereof, the words "Control of Salvage".

3. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of the Island of Sark for registration on the Records of those Islands respectively.

4. This Order shall come into force on the 22nd day of April, 1950.
