**The Defence (Finance) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 1945.**

ORDER OF THE ROYAL COURT MADE IN
PURSUANCE OF THE SUPPLIES AND
SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(GUERNSEY) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946,

ENTITLED

**The Defence (Finance) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 1945, Amendment Order, 1954.**

The Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council,

1946, and in pursuance of Article sixty-four of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. The following provisions of Regulation nine of the Defence (Finance) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, are hereby revoked, namely:—
 - (a) in paragraph (1) (which applies Part V of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945), the words “subject to the subsequent provisions of this Regulation”; and
 - (b) paragraph (2) (which provides inter alia that the maximum fine which may be imposed on a person convicted of an offence against any of those Regulations in relation to any security or gold shall be such fine as is authorised by Regulation ninety-two of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, or a fine equal to three times the value of the security or gold, whichever is the larger).

2. The following provisions of Regulation nine B of the said Regulations are hereby revoked, namely:—
 - (a) in paragraph (1), the proviso (which renders unlawful the making of an agreement to do at a future time an act the doing of which at the time of the agreement is not lawful except with the consent of the Finance Committee of the States of Guernsey); and
 - (b) paragraph (2) (which contains a saving for Regulation ninety of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945).

3. The following provisions of Regulation ten of the said Regulations (which relates to the interpretation of the said Regulations) are hereby revoked, namely:—
 - (a) in paragraph (1) the definitions of “bank-notes”, “Finance Committee”, “foreign currency” and “owner”; and
 - (b) in paragraph (2) the words “or the Finance Committee of the States of Guernsey”.
4. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted by Her Majesty’s Greffier to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of Sark for registration on the respective Records of those Islands.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-seventh day of March, 1954.
