The Royal Court (Costs and Fees) (Amendment) Rules, 1994

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Royal Court (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) Law, 1969(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to Rules of 1990.

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 22 of the Schedule to the Royal Court (Costs and Fees) Rules, 1990(b), the fee payable in respect of a Commissioner who is an Advocate shall be such fee as may be specified by the Bailiff at the time of the Commissioner's appointment.
