The Royal Court (Costs and Fees) (Taxation Amendments) Rules, 1999

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the power conferred on it by section 1 of the Royal Court (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) Law, 1969 (a) hereby orders:-

Taxation by Bailiff etc.

1. In Rule 7 of the Royal Court (Costs and Fees) Rules, 1990(b):
 - (a) at the end of the words in paragraph (3) there is inserted “: provided that if in any particular case the Bailiff is of the opinion that it is just and convenient so to do, he may instead nominate himself, or the Deputy Bailiff, or a Lieutenant Bailiff to conduct the taxation”;
 - (b) in paragraph (5) for “member” there is substituted “person”.
