ENTITLED

THE CONTROL OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES
(APPOINTMENT OF COMPETENT AUTHORITY)
(ALDERNEY) ORDER, 1950.

WHEREAS by the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, Amendment (Alderney) Order, 1949, the Royal Court appointed the President of the Alderney Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities to be the Competent Authority in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, as respects the Island of Alderney:

WHEREAS the States of Alderney, by their Resolution of the 26th day of April, 1950, resolved that in future the head of every Alderney States Committee should be called the Chairman of that Committee :

NOW THEREFORE the Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1946, as varied by Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders :—

1.—The said Order of 1949 is hereby amended by the substitution, in section 1 thereof, for the word “ President ”, where that word first occurs, of the word “ Chairman ”, and in section 2 thereof, for the word “ President ”, wherever that word occurs, of the word “Chairman”.

2.—This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 27th day of April, 1950, and shall be transmitted by His Majesty's Greffier to the Clerk of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island.

3.—The said Order of 1949 and this Order may be cited together as the Control of Essential Commodities (Appointment of Competent Authority) (Alderney) Orders, 1949 and 1950.
