PURSUANCE OF ARTICLE 2 OF THE EMERGENCY
LAWS (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS)
(GUERNSEY) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1952,

**The Defence (General) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 1945, Amendment (No. 2)
Order, 1953.**

The Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1952, and in

pursuance of Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, hereby orders:—

1. The following Regulations of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, are hereby revoked, namely:—

<i>Number of Regulation</i>	<i>Subject Matter</i>
2BA	Control of explosives.
89	Use of force in entering premises.
95	Recovery of expenses.

2. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of Sark for registration on the respective Records of those Islands.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the tenth day of October, 1953.
