

PURSUANCE OF THE SUPPLIES AND SER-  
VICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (GUERNSEY)  
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946,

**The Defence (General) (Guernsey)  
Regulations, 1945, Amendment (No. 1)  
Order, 1956.**

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council,

1946, and in pursuance of Article sixty-four of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. In paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section two of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, Amendment (No. 1) Order, 1955, the words “electricity and” and the words “to electricity and” are hereby revoked.

2. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of Sark for registration on the respective records of those Islands.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
