The Criminal Appeals (Alderney) Rules 1964

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section three of the Government of Alderney Law, 1948, hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. The reference in section twenty-one of the Government of Alderney Law, 1948, to the Royal

Court shall, in relation to appeals in criminal matters from decisions of the Court of Alderney and the stating of a case by the Court in criminal matters in pursuance of the provisions of that section, be a reference to the Royal Court sitting as a Full Court.

2. These Rules may be cited as the Criminal Appeals (Alderney) Rules, 1964.

3. These Rules shall come into force on the fourteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.
