The Royal Court (Plaids d'Héritage) Order, 1982

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Articles sixty-four of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a), section twelve of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:—

Sitting of
Court "en
Plaids
d'Héritage".

1. Paragraph 5 of the Saisie Procedure (Simplification) (Bailiwick) Order, 1952. as amended(c), is hereby deleted and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

"In Guernsey, sittings of the Court "en Plaids d'Héritage" shall be held on the first Thursday of each calendar month both in and out of Term. Each such sitting shall, as hitherto, be styled a "Tour" and each such sitting in each calendar year shall be denoted by the number in French appropriate to that sitting in that calendar year."

Quorum.

2. A quorum of the Court "en Plaids d'Héritage" shall consist of the Bailiff, the Deputy Bailiff or a Lieutenant-Bailiff and two Jurats.

Repeal.

3. The Royal Court (Days of Sitting) Order, 1973 is hereby repealed.

Citation.

4. This Order may be cited as the Royal Court (Plaids d'Héritage) Order, 1982.

Commence-
ment.

5. (1) This Order other than paragraphs 1 and 3 thereof shall come into force on the first day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

(2) Paragraphs 1 and 3 of this Order shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.
