## **The Committal Proceedings (Written Statements) (Amendment) Rules, 1986**

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a), section 12 of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950(b), section 25 of the Magistrate's Court (Guernsey) Law, 1954(c), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders—

Amendment  
to Rules of  
1983.

1. Paragraph 1(5) of the Committal Proceedings (Written Statements) Rules, 1983(d), (hereinafter called "the principal Rules") is repealed and the following substituted therefor—

" (5) At the commencement of the Committal proceedings the Court shall inform the parties to the proceedings that they have the right to require that any statement admitted in evidence by virtue of this paragraph shall be read aloud at the proceedings and any statement in respect of which such a requirement is made, or in respect of which the Court so directs, shall be read aloud at the proceedings."

Saving.

2. These Rules shall have effect only in relation to committal proceedings commenced after the coming into force of these Rules.

3. These Rules may be cited as the Committal Proceedings (Written Statements) (Amendment) Rules, 1986.
