(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2010**

The Employment Protection (Appeals and References) (Amendment) Order, 2010

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 25, 26 and 35(1)(a) of the Employment Protection (Guernsey) Law, 1998^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of article 11 of principal order.

1. Article 11 of the Employment Protection (Appeals and References) Order, 2006^b is amended as follows –

(a) in the definition of "**complaint**" in paragraph (1), delete the expression "(a), (b) or (c)", and

(b) for paragraph (3), substitute the following paragraph –

"(3) References in this Order to the person chairing the Tribunal include, in relation to any function conferred on that person by this Order –

(a) references to any member of the Tribunal appointed by him to undertake that function, and

(b) where the Tribunal is constituted

by one member, references to that member."

Interpretation.

2. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(2) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Employment Protection (Appeals and References) (Amendment) Order, 2010.

Commencement.

4. This Order comes into force on the 1st October, 2010.
