VICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (GUERNSEY)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946,

**The Defence (General) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 1945, Amendment (No. 2)
Order, 1954.**

The Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1946, and in pursuance of Article sixty-four of the

Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. Regulation eighty-eight of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945 (which authorises the charging of fees in respect of the grant, renewal or issue of permits, licences, certificates or other documents issued under the said Regulations) is hereby revoked.

2. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of Sark for registration on the respective Records of those Islands.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the ninth day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-four.
