Execution of arrest of personalty	15s. 0d.	Her Majesty's Sheriff
Execution of arrest of wages of judgment debtor	10s. 0d.	Her Majesty's Sheriff
Sale of furniture and effects of judgment debtor	The expenses reasonably incurred in connection with the sale.	Her Majesty's Sheriff
