The Companies (Applications for change of name) Procedure Rules, 1989

THE ROYAL COURT, in pursuance of Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law 1948(a), Section 12 of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:—

1. Applications for the approval of a special resolution of the shareholders of a limited liability
