The Royal Court (Alderney Committal)

Rule, 1953

The Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section three of the Government of Alderney Law, 1948, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:—

The Rule of Court set out in the Schedule hereto shall have effect in relation to committals from the Court of Alderney to the Royal Court under the provisions of section twenty of the Government of Alderney Law, 1948.
