The Royal Court (Non-contentious Applications) (Amendment) Rules, 1989

THE ROYAL COURT, in pursuance of Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a), Section 12 of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:—

Amendment to the Rules of 1988.

1. The First Schedule to the Royal Court (non-contentious applications) Rules, 1988(c) (hereinafter called "The Principal Rules") is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:—

"5. Application for permission to register the will of realty of a deceased person.

6. Applications under Article 4 of the "Loi relative aux prescriptions" registered on the 4th of January, 1890(d), to limit prescription."

Citation, collective title and commencement.

2. (1) These Rules may be cited as the Royal Court (Non-Contentious Applications) (Amendment) Rules, 1989.

(2) These Rules and the Principal Rules may be cited together as the Royal Court (Non-Contentious Applications) Rules, 1988 and 1989

(3) These Rules shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1989.
