ORDER OF THE ROYAL COURT MADE IN
PURSUANCE OF THE SUPPLIES AND SER-
VICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (GUERNSEY)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946,

ENTITLED

**The Defence (General) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 1945, Amendment (No. 1)
Order, 1952.**

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1946, and in pursuance of Article 64 of the Reform

(Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. The following provisions of Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, are hereby revoked, namely:—

- (a) paragraph (1G) (which makes provision for securing that persons offending against certain provisions of the Regulation shall not be tried by a court of summary jurisdiction); and
- (b) paragraph (4) (which empowers the Competent Authority to appoint a controller of an undertaking).

2. Regulation sixty-two of the said Regulations (which contains provisions with respect to the control of cultivation, management or use of land for agricultural purposes) is hereby revoked.

3. In paragraph (1) of Regulation ninety of the said Regulations (which penalises a person who attempts to commit, conspires with another to commit or does any act preparatory to the commission of an offence against any of those Regulations) the words “or does any act preparatory to the commission of” are hereby revoked.

4. The following provisions of Regulation one hundred of the said Regulations (which by reason of the revocation of the provisions of other Regulations have become of no effect) are hereby revoked, namely:—

- (a) in paragraph (1) the definitions of “the enemy”, “enemy alien”, “prisoner of war”, “protected place”, “road vehicle”, “seaplane”, “wireless transmitting apparatus” and “wireless receiving apparatus”; and
- (b) paragraphs (1A) and (4).

5. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of Sark for registration on the respective Records of those Islands.

6. This Order shall come into operation on the tenth day of December, 1952.
