The Shorthand Notes and Transcripts (Criminal Cases) (Amendment) Rules, 1990

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 41(2) of the Court of Appeal (Guernsey) Law, 1961(a), hereby orders:—

Amendment of 1964 Rules.

1. In the Shorthand Notes and Transcripts (Criminal Cases) (Guernsey) Rules, 1964(b), as amended(c)—

- (a) In Rule 5(1)(a), for the words following “that person,” substitute “in respect of each A4 side or part thereof, the sum of £6;”;
- (b) in Rule 5(1)(b), for the words following “that person,” substitute “in respect of each A4 side or part thereof, the sum of £1.”.
