*The Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945,
Amendment (No. 3) Order, 1950.*

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1948, and of Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. Paragraph (3) of Regulation 88A of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, is hereby revoked.

2. The Ordinance directing that certain Defence Regulations shall have effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey, of the 16th day of February, 1946, is hereby amended—

- (a) by adding, in the First Schedule thereto, in the first column, after the figures and letter “ 88A ” the words “ other than paragraph (3) ” ;
- (b) by revoking, in the third column of the said Schedule, opposite the said figures and letter 88A, any reference to the third paragraph of that Regulation.

3. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of the Island of Sark for registration on the Records of those Islands respectively.

4. This Order shall come into force on the 25th day of November, 1950.
