**PRACTICE DIRECTION No. 11 of 2003**

**The Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1993, as amended**

I am directed by the Bailiff to issue the following Practice Direction:-

1. All applications for liquor licences and/or family permits must include
  - (i) As respects liquor licenses, “a full description of the premises for which the application is made” (s.2 (2) (b)); and
  - (ii) As respects family permits “a description of the premises and a plan thereof for which the application is made” (s.44 (b)). S. 43 (4) provides that a family permit shall only apply to that part of the licensed premises for which it is granted and specified on the face of the permit.
  
2. For example, it will in future no longer be sufficient to simply to apply for a general liquor licence and family permit “in place of an identical general licence and family permit currently held by [the existing licensee]”
