PRACTICE DIRECTION NO 3 of 2009

**Application for Compulsory Winding Up and Administration Orders under The
Companies (Guernsey) Law 2008**

I am directed by the Deputy Bailiff to issue the following Practice Direction.

1. Applications for Compulsory Winding Up and Administration Orders under The Companies (Guernsey) Law 2008 will in the normal course of events be heard in the Tuesday Ordinary Courts as fixed in the Royal Court Calendar for each year and set aside for the hearing, *inter alia*, of this type of business.
2. If however an advocate wishes any such application to be heard urgently he should lodge with the Greffe a letter (together with five copies of the application and other relevant paperwork) setting out his reasons for seeking to have his application heard earlier than the next Tuesday Ordinary Court.
3. Any such letter would be for the attention of the Judge alone and not put before the Jurats.
4. In the event of an early date being fixed the advocate for the opposing party would be at liberty to apply for an adjournment notwithstanding any letter submitted by the applicant.
