The Family Allowances (Qualifications)(Amendment)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1983.

Made 6 January, 1983
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 10 January, 1983

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (1) of section twenty-one of the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended^(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to regulation fourteen of the principal regulations

1. Sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) of the proviso to regulation fourteen of the Family Allowances (Qualifications)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1977 is hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"(b) any attendance which is less than full-time may, nevertheless, be deemed to be full-time if in the opinion of the Administrator, this would be reasonable in all the circumstances."

Citation and collective title


2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Family Allowances (Qualifications)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1983.

(2) These regulations and the Family Allowances(Qualifications) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1977 may be cited together as the Family Allowances (Qualifications)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1977 to 1983.

Commencement

3. These regulations shall come into force on the tenth day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

Regulation one of these regulations amends regulation fourteen of the principal regulations so as to permit education which is not full-time to be deemed to be full-time where it is reasonable so to do in the opinion of the Administrator.
