The Fishing (Prohibition on the Importation of
Molluscan Shellfish) Order, 1987

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Made: 23rd January 1987

Laid before the States:

Coming into Operation: 30th January 1987

THE STATES SEA FISHERIES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 13A of the Fishing Ordinance, 1969, as amended (a), and being satisfied that for the purposes of preventing the spread of disease or pests being carried by fish it is expedient so to do, hereby orders:-

1. The importation into this Island of molluscan shellfish from France is hereby prohibited unless such molluscan shellfish is imported subject to such conditions as may be imposed under and in accordance with a licence which shall have been granted in that behalf by the Committee under the provisions of section 13A of the Ordinance of 1969.
2. In the Order, the expression "the Ordinance of 1969" means the Fishing Ordinance, 1969, as amended, and any other expressions have the same meanings as in the Ordinance of 1969.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as the Fishing (Prohibition on the Importation of Molluscan Shellfish) Order, 1987.
5. This Order shall come into force on the 30th day of January 1987.
