**Import and Export of Goods (Control)
(Alderney) (Amendment) Order, 2001**

The Policy & Finance Committee in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 1 of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Law, 1946, hereby orders:—

1. In Schedule 1 to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Order 1995(a) as amended (b) entry number 7 is hereby repealed.-
2. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) (Amendment) Order 2001 and shall come into force on the 27 January 2001.

This Order removes marine anti-fouling paint from Schedule 1 to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Order 1995. That schedule lists goods, which may not be imported from the UK without a licence. Controls on the importation of such paint are now contained in The Control of Poisonous Substances Regulation, 1995.
