THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, eighteen, twenty, twenty-three, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Amendments to

Order of 1973.

1. The Post Office (Inland Post) Order, 1973, as amended(b) is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) in section seven thereof -

(i) immediately after the words "of the Third Schedule" insert the words "and the Eighth Schedule";

(ii) the words "of the said Schedule" are repealed and the words "of the said Schedules" are substituted therefor;

(b) in subsection (2) of section seventeen thereof the words "forty new pence in respect of any postal packet" are repealed and the words "fifty-five new pence in respect of any postal packet" are substituted therefor;

(c) in section eighteen thereof -

(i) in subsection (2) the table is repealed and the table set out in the First Schedule to this Order is substituted therefor;

(ii) subsections (5) and (6) are repealed and the following subsections are substituted therefor -

"(5) Where notice has been given under the provisions of section ten of the Post Office (Postal Packets) Ordinance, 1973, requiring entry to be made of the goods in a parcel which is received in the Bailiwick from the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man or Jersey and the parcel remains in the custody of the Board at some place appointed by the States Board of Administration for customs examination for a period of more than one month after the date of such notice, or such longer period as the States Board of Administration may allow, the Board may charge (in addition to any other fees payable under this Order) a fee as follows:-

(a) where a parcel or parcels are stored for a period not exceeding twenty-eight days, the fee shall be one pound and seventy new pence for each parcel, except where two or more parcels are posted simultaneously by a sender to the same addressee, when the fee shall be:-

(i) where there are not more than five parcels, one pound and forty new pence for each parcel;

- (ii) where there are more than five parcels but not more than thirty, one pound and forty new pence for each of the first five parcels and then eighty new pence for each additional parcel;
  - (iii) where there are more than thirty parcels, for the first thirty parcels the fee for each as prescribed in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of this subsection, fifty pence for each additional parcel after the first thirty up to three hundred and then forty-five new pence for each additional parcel thereafter;
- (b) where a parcel is stored for a period of more than twenty-eight days, the fee for each parcel shall be as in paragraph (a) of this subsection with an additional sum for each parcel calculated at the rate of ten new pence for each working day (or residual part of such day) of storage after the first twenty-eight days.
- (6) The fees charged under subsection (5) of this section with respect to each parcel (other than a parcel which is returned to its sender) shall be paid by the addressee if the parcel shall be delivered to him, or by the original addressee if the parcel shall be re-addressed in accordance with paragraph (c) or (d) of subsection (1) of this section.";

- (d) in paragraph (b) of subsection (3) of section twenty-three thereof the words "ten new pence" are repealed and the words "twelve new pence" are substituted therefor;
- (e) subsection (5) of section twenty-six thereof is repealed and the following subsection is substituted therefor -
- "(5) Where the Board accepts a rebate posting for transmission under the provisions of this section and the sender complies with the said conditions, the Board shall refund to the sender or allow him in account, where the number of the postal packets comprised in the rebate posting is above five thousand, one tenth of the total postage charged on those packets";
- (f) in subsection (3) of section thirty-one thereof the words "ten new pence" are repealed and the words "twelve new pence" are substituted therefor;
- (g) in subsections (2) and (3) of section thirty-eight thereof the words "ten new pence" are repealed and the words "twelve new pence" are substituted therefor;
- (h) in section forty-one thereof the words "fifteen pounds" are repealed and the words "eighteen pounds" are substituted therefor;
- (i) in column two of the Third Schedule thereto in the entry relating to item "1. Letter" immediately after the words "Greatest dimension : 900 m m" insert the following words -
- "(Minimum size for envelopes or cards; length : 100 m m; width : 70 m m)";
- (j) Part I of the Fifth Schedule thereto is repealed and the Part set out in the Second Schedule to this Order is substituted therefor;

(k) Part I of the Sixth Schedule thereto is repealed and the Part set out in the Third Schedule to this Order is substituted therefor;

(l) in column two of the Eighth Schedule thereto in the entry relating to item "1. Letter" immediately after the words "Greatest dimension : 900 m m" insert the following words -

"(Minimum size for envelopes or cards; length : 100 m m; width 70 m m)";

(m) the First and Seventh Schedules thereto are repealed and the Schedules set out in the Fourth and Fifth Schedules to this Order are respectively substituted therefor.
