

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1986 No. 1

The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1986

Made: 2nd January, 1986.

Coming into operation: 7th January, 1986.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of 2nd March, 1929 (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b), and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle of an overall width in excess of six feet six inches shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive that vehicle on the one-way portion of Havelet, Saint Peter Port.

2. In these Regulations -

"Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force;


"the one-way portion of Havelet" means the portion of Havelet referred to in Paragraph 20 of Part I of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970 (c);

"vehicle" has the meaning assigned to it by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of 2nd March, 1929.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1986.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 7th day of January, 1986 and shall continue in force until the 1st day of July, 1986.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport)

A portion of Havelet, Saint Peter Port, is a designated one-way street, requiring traffic to proceed from the direction of its junction with Hauteville towards the wider part of the road adjacent to the Hotel de Havelet and a house named "Le Coin"; further, vehicles exceeding two tons unladen weight are not permitted to travel in this portion of Havelet. The effect of these Regulations is that in addition to the above-mentioned requirements, from 7th January, 1986 until 1st July 1986, vehicles of an overall width in excess of 6ft 6ins are not permitted to use that portion of Havelet in which the one-way traffic and weight restrictions are in force.
