### The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1995

**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 8, 11, 20 and 116 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

#### Replacement of Regulation 30

1. Regulation 30 of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended(b), (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations") is repealed and replaced by the following :-

#### *"Payment of Class 3 contributions*

30. (1) The provisions of the last foregoing regulation shall have effect in relation to an insured person who is liable to pay a Class 3 contribution, other than a person who has attained pensionable age, in all respects as if the references in that regulation to a Class 2 contribution, a Class 2 social insurance card and a Class 2 contribution card were substituted respectively by references to a Class 3 contribution, a Class 3 social insurance card and a Class 3 contribution card.

(2) A person who has attained pensionable age and is liable to pay a Class 3 contribution shall, in relation to any contribution quarter in which he is so liable, either:

- (a) make arrangement with the Authority in such manner as the Authority may require for the payment of contributions by direct debit; or
- (b) pay to the Authority the contributions due, being set out in a statement sent to him on behalf of the Authority during such period immediately following the end of each contribution quarter as the Authority may direct, within a period of 28 days immediately after receipt of such statement."

### **Amendment of Regulation 43**

2. In Regulation 43(b) of the principal Regulations the words "or Class 3" are deleted.

### **Addition of Regulation 43A**

3. Immediately after Regulation 43 there is inserted the following :

"43A Where a person of pensionable age is an employed or self-employed person, he shall nevertheless be liable to pay a Class 3 contribution at such percentage as the States may, from time to time, by Ordinance prescribe."

### **Extent**

4. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

### **Repeals**

5. The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994(c) are repealed.

### **Citation**

6. These Regulations may be cited as The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1995.

### **Commencement**

7. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st January, 1996.
