THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT)


(ALDERNEY) ORDER, 1992

The States Finance Committee in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Alderney) Law, 1946, (a) hereby orders :-

- 1. In the first Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Order, 1991, the following entry shall be inserted after the entry relating to feedstuffs intended to be fed to ruminants :-

"15. The tail of any lobster or the claw of any lobster, edible crab or spinous spider crab, the tail or claw of which, as the case may be, is separated from such lobster, edible crab or spinous spider crab."

- 2. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) (Alderney) Order 1992, and shall come into force on the 11th day of June 1992.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of the Amendment Order is to prohibit the importation into Alderney of lobster claws and tails and crabs claws which have been separated from the body of the crustacean concerned, except under the authority of an Import Licence.
