
Coming into operation ..... 22nd March, 1974

The States of Guernsey Emergency Council, as respects the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney, and the States of Alderney Finance Committee, as respects the Island of Alderney, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them respectively by subsection (1) of section two of the Fuel and Electricity (Control) Act 1973, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Fuel and Electricity (Control) Act 1973 (Guernsey) Order 1973, and of all other powers enabling them respectively in that behalf, hereby order:-


1. This Order may be cited as the Fuel and Electricity (Control) (Revocation) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1974.
2. The Fuel and Electricity (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973, the Fuel and Electricity (Control) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1974, and the Fuel and Electricity (Control) (Amendment) (No. 2) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1974, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended  
to indicate its general purport).

This Order revokes the Fuel and Electricity (Control)  
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973, as amended, so that  
the restrictions imposed by the latter Order, as amended,  
on the use of electricity and other fuel for the purpose  
of heating and on the use of electricity for the purpose  
of lighting shall cease to have effect on the 22nd March,  
1974.
