The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1984

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 12 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

Amendments to the Regulations of 1983

1. The Second and Third Schedules to the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Regulations") (b), are hereby repealed and the Schedules set out in the First and Second Schedules to these Regulations are hereby respectively substituted therefor.

Repeal

2. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 (c), is hereby repealed.

Extent

3. These Regulations and the Principal Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1984.

Collective Title

5. These Regulations and the Principal Regulations may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 and 1984.

Commencement

6. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1984.

Additional dispensing fees payable in respect of pharmaceutical benefit

Where an item of pharmaceutical benefit is a controlled drug within the meaning of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974, and it has been supplied on a prescription endorsed by the approved supplier with the initial letters "C.D."	41p
Where an item of pharmaceutical benefit which -  (a) requires the addition by an approved supplier of a vehicle/diluent has a stability of less than fourteen days and it is necessary for pharmaceutical reasons for it to be supplied in more than one container; and  (b) the medical prescription on which that item is supplied is endorsed with the number of additional containers in which that item is supplied	24p for each additional container

Additional dispensing fees payable in respect of pharmaceutical benefit supplied on medical prescriptions endorsed "URGENT" or "DISPENSED URGENTLY" in accordance with Regulation 3

(1) Time of supply	(2) Dispensing fee
On any day, other than a Sunday and a bank holiday, between the time the premises of the approved supplier are closed for the supply of pharmaceutical benefit and eleven o'clock in the afternoon	£7.60
On a Sunday or a bank holiday, between nine o'clock in the forenoon and eleven o'clock in the afternoon	£9.70
On any day between eleven o'clock in the afternoon of the next previous day and nine o'clock in the forenoon or such earlier time at which the premises of the approved supplier are open for the supply of pharmaceutical benefit	£9.70

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 (as amended), so as to provide for an increase in the fees payable in respect of certain items of pharmaceutical benefit which are extemporaneously dispensed or are dispensed urgently.
