The Immigration (Control on Entry) (EEC and other Non-Commonwealth Nationals)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Rules 1980

The States Board of Administration in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection 2 of section three of the Immigration Act 1971, as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1972, hereby makes the following Rules:-

Amendment to Rules of 1973

1. The Immigration (Control on Entry) (EEC and other Non-Commonwealth Nationals) (Guernsey) Rules 1973, as amended (a) are hereby amended as follows:-

in the Appendix thereto the reference to Iran shall be deleted.

2. These Rules may be cited as the Immigration (Control on Entry) (EEC and other Non-Commonwealth Nationals) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Rules 1980.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Rules further amend the Immigration (Control on Entry) (EEC and other Non-Commonwealth Nationals) (Guernsey) Rules 1973, as amended, so as to require a national of Iran to produce a United Kingdom visa issued for the purpose for which he seeks entry into the Bailiwick.
