The Post Office (Money Order) (Repeals) Order, 1978

Made 30th May, 1978
Laid before the States ... 1978
Coming into Operation 1st June, 1978

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections twenty-nine, thirty-three and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Repeals.

1. The Post Office (Money Order) Order, 1975(b), and the Post Office (Money Order) (Amendment) Order, 1977(c), are hereby repealed.

Savings.

2. The repeals in the last preceding section shall be without prejudice to the payment under and in accordance with the provisions of the Orders repealed as aforesaid of any money order issued before this Order comes into force and payable in the Bailiwick.

Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Money Order) (Repeals) Order, 1978.

Commencement.

4. This Order shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight.
