The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1987

Made: 31st March, 1987.

Coming into operation: 4th April 1987.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of 2nd March, 1929 (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b), and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed along La Rue Traversée, Castel, otherwise than from south-west to north-east.

2. In these Regulations -

"animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of 2nd March 1929;

"Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force;


"La Rue Traversée" means the northernmost of the two roads lying between the Route de Cobo, Castel and the junction of La Ruelle de la Tour and La Ruelle Saumarez, Castel.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1987.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 4th day of April, 1987 and shall continue in force until the 30th day of September 1987.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport)

The effect of these Regulations is that from 4th April, 1987 to 30th September, 1987 La Rue Traversée, Castel will be a one-way street, traffic being required to travel from the direction of the Route de Cobo towards its junction with the Ruelle de la Tour, Ruelle Saumarez and the road known as the Ruelle de la Pouquelah.
