The Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity
Benefit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1981.

Made 7th April, 1981
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st May, 1981

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twenty-three of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation six of the principal regulations

1. Immediately after paragraph (2) of regulation six of the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 ^(a) there is hereby inserted the following paragraph numbered (3):-

"(3) For the purposes of unemployment benefit, where a person is an employed person and his employment as such has not been terminated, then in any week a day on which in the normal course that person would not work in that employment or in any other employment shall not be treated as a day of unemployment."

Citation and collective title

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1981.



Commencement

3. These regulations shall come into force on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

Regulation one amends regulation six of the principal regulations so that in respect of an employed person whose employment has not been terminated a day shall not be a day of unemployment if it is a day on which that person would not normally work in that employment or any other employment.
