The States Agriculture and Countryside Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 11(2) of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, as amended (a), hereby orders:

1. The definition of "animals" in Section 15 of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952 shall include "rabbits, hares, wild boar and deer" for the purposes of Part II of that Ordinance.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b) applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Animals (Extension of Definition) Order, 2001
4. This Order shall come into force on 13 March 2001.
