**The Data Protection (Public Information Designation)
Order, 2002**

THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 34(2)(a) of the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2001^a and all other powers enabling it, hereby makes the following Order -

Designation of States information held by the Island Archives Service.

1. States' information held by the Island Archives Service is designated for the purposes of section 34(2)(a) of the Law.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires -

“**Island Archives Service**” means the archives service established by resolution of the States of 23rd June 1986;

“**the Law**” means the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law 2001;

“records” include -

- (a) written documents; and
- (b) any other form of information recording system (including, for the avoidance of doubt, an electronic system),

capable of conveying or disclosing information to a living individual; and

“States’ information” means information contained in or upon records belonging to the States.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b apply to the interpretation of this Order -

- (a) throughout the Bailiwick; and
- (b) as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Unless the context otherwise requires, references in this Order to an enactment are references thereto as amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.


3. This Order may be cited as the Data Protection (Public Information Designation) Order, 2002.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Order)

The Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law 2001 ("the Law") imposes certain obligations on data controllers to give data subjects information about the processing of personal data and to give access to personal data. Under section 34 of the Law, the States Advisory and Finance Committee may designate certain information as "public information", which, as such, is exempt from the subject information and certain other provisions of the Law. This Order has the effect of designating information belonging to the States and held by the Island Archives Service as "public information" for the purposes of the Law.
