The Disposal of Explosives (Exemption) Order, 1992

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 7 of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985(a), as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985 (Guernsey) Order 1987(b), hereby makes the following order:-

Exemptions from the Act.

1. The operations specified in section 2 shall not need a licence under Part II of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985 if they satisfy the conditions specified in section 3.

Exempted operations.

2. The operations referred to in section 1 are the disposal and destruction at sea of explosives, ordnance and munitions.

Conditions to be observed.

3. The conditions referred to in section 1 are that-

- (a) the Chief Officer of Police or (if he is absent or indisposed) his deputy shall be satisfied that the risk to public safety presented by the

substances in question is so serious that the operations ought to be carried out forthwith and before a licence can reasonably be expected to be granted;

- (b) the operations shall be carried out by a member of the salaried police force of the Island of Guernsey or by a person authorised in writing in that behalf by the said Chief Officer or deputy;
- (c) the operations shall be carried out in accordance with any written instructions of the Board as to the manner, times or locations in which such operations are to be carried out; and
- (d) the said Chief Officer or deputy shall, as soon as is reasonably practicable after the operations have been carried out, report the matter in writing to the Board.

Interpretation.

4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as if it were an enactment.

Citation.


5. This Order may be cited as the Disposal of Explosives (Exemption) Order, 1992.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This order exempts from the licensing requirements of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985 the disposal and destruction by the police of explosives at sea in cases of emergency.
