The Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Payment of Approved Suppliers)
(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978

Made 18th July, 1978
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st September, 1978

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twelve of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders :-

Amendment of regulation two of the principal regulations

1. Paragraph (1) of regulation two of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Payment of Approved Suppliers)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1976 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"), is hereby further amended as follows :-

- (a) in sub-paragraph (c) thereof, the figures and word "3.00 pence" are hereby repealed and the figures and word "3.50 pence" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in sub-paragraph (d)(ii) thereof, the words "one hundred and five pence" are hereby repealed and the words "two pounds" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) in sub-paragraph (e) thereof, the words "fifteen pence" are hereby repealed and the words "twenty-four pence" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment of First Schedule to the principal regulations

2. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment of Second Schedule to the principal regulations

3. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to these regulations is hereby substituted therefor.


Citation and Commencement

4.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978.

(2) These regulations and the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Payment of Approved Suppliers)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1976 to 1977, may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976 to 1978.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the first day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight.

Dispensing fees payable in respect of pharmaceutical benefit
extemporaneously dispensed

(1) Description of pharmaceutical benefit	(2) Dispensing fee
Cachets, capsules, pills, tablet- triturates, lozenges, pastilles, pessaries, suppositories, enteric coating of tablets	£1.00
Liquids prepared with aseptic technique	£1.00
Individually wrapped powders	£1.40

Additional dispensing fees payable in respect of pharmaceutical benefit supplied on medical prescriptions endorsed "URGENT" or "DISPENSED URGENTLY" in accordance with regulation three

(1) Time of Supply	(2) Dispensing fee
On any day, other than a Sunday and a bank holiday, between the time when the premises of the approved supplier are closed for the supply of pharmaceutical benefit and eleven o'clock in the afternoon	£2.64
On a Sunday or a bank holiday, between nine o'clock in the forenoon and eleven o'clock in the afternoon	£5.28
On any day, between eleven o'clock in the afternoon of the next previous day and nine o'clock in the forenoon or such earlier time at which the premises of the approved supplier are open for the supply of pharmaceutical benefit	£5.28

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These regulations further amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Payment of Approved Suppliers)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1976, by increasing certain of the amounts payable to approved suppliers in respect of drugs and medicines supplied by them under and in accordance with the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972.
