THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1978

AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE OPEN GENERAL EXPORT LICENCE

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of its powers under section 3 of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1978(a) hereby modifies the Open General Export Licence granted by the said Board upon the 10 June 1980(b) as follows:-

1. In Article 1, immediately before the reference to China there shall be inserted the word "Argentina".
2. This amendment shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Export Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of this Amendment is to prohibit the exportation of any goods to Argentina except under the authority of an individual Export Licence.
